# BCSC “2020” Vision

- **2015 – Beyond**
  - Prepare students for tomorrow
  - Utilize one to one access to technology to individualize instruction
  - Support technology in the classroom
- **2014 - One to One at BIS & BPS**
  - 1,000 students receive iPad 2 and iPad Mini
- **2013 - One to One at BMS**
  - 450 students receive 11" MacBook Air Laptop
- **2012 - One to One at BHS**
  - 750 students receive 13" MacBook Air Laptop
- **2011 - Prepare for One to One**
  - Infrastructure, wireless access, staff development

- Height: 9.50 inches
- Width: 7.31 inches
- Weight: 1.33 pounds
- Capacity: 16GB
- 9.7-inch (diagonal) LED Display
- Case – Bump Armor

# iPad Care

- Restart the iPad weekly
- Charge each night
  - Expected to be charged each morning at school
- Keep the Screen clean
  - Use a soft, slightly water dampened, lint free cloth
  - Do not use window cleaners, household cleaners, or abrasives
- Insurance available

**Visit the Help Desk with problems**



# Do Not...

- Leave iPad unattended
- Apply liquids to the screen or openings
- Eat or drink around the iPad
- Expose the iPad to extreme heat or cold
- Using sharp objects on it
- Remove the iPad from the case
- Avoid placing weight on the iPad
- Never throw or slide the iPad
- Remove the identification label
- Lend iPad to another





# Proper iPad / Internet Use

- iPad provided for academic purposes
- Content filter at school and home to keep safe while on the Internet
- Students should not:
  - Delete any device Profiles
  - Bypass the network and content filter
  - Go to inappropriate sites
  - Send or Post inappropriate messages to others.
  - Use games and Messages during class time.
  - Use another student's user name or password
  - Tamper with hardware



# Charges for repair of iPad:

- Glass/Digitizer Repair- \$99.00
  - LCD Repair- \$109.00
  - Glass/Digitizer and LCD Repair- \$159.00
  - Battery- \$79.00
  - Charging Port- \$69.00
  - Headphone Jack- \$69.00
  - iPad 16gb- \$399.00
  - BumpArmor Protective case- \$19.40
- \*All damages should be reported to the Help Desk in a timely fashion**



# Respectable Use Policy

- iPad and Internet Guideline - at School and Home
  - **Respect Yourself.** I will show respect for myself through my actions.
  - **Protect Yourself.** I will ensure that the information I post online will not put me at risk.
  - **Respect Others.** I will show respect to others.
  - **Protect Others.** I will protect others by reporting abuse.
  - **Act With Integrity.** I will cite sources for media and information.
  - **Protect Intellectual Property.** I will protect intellectual property.

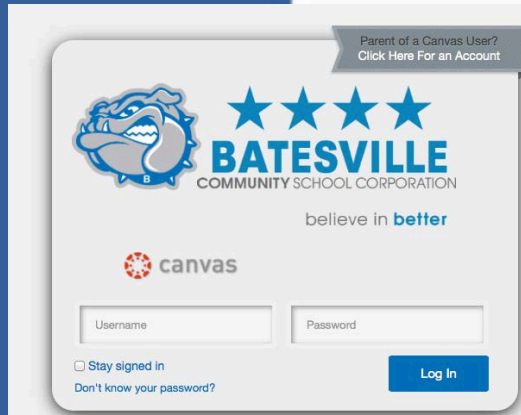
