Young Hoosier Book Award Program and Summer Reading Program

Our goal is to make all of our students readers. Your child can work toward that goal by participating in the Young Hoosier Book Award (YHBA) or participating in a Summer Reading Program.

Opportunities:

1. Students reading and passing an Accelerated Reader quiz for a minimum of five (5) books from the middle school YHBA list by **April 13, 2018** will be eligible to:
 - * vote for the state winner book and
 - * participate in the YHBA Voting Celebration in late April 2018.
2. Students reading and passing an Accelerated Reader quiz for a minimum of fifteen (15) books from the middle school YHBA list by **April 13, 2018**, will be eligible to:
 - * vote for the state winner book,
 - * participate in the YHBA Voting Celebration in late April 2018, and receive a trophy.
3. **Summer Program** - Students reading and passing Accelerated Reader quizzes for ANY book with a minimum of eight (8) books worth at least 5 points by **August 9, 2017** will be eligible to:
 - * participate in a pizza party given on August 18, 2017 in the BMS media center during lunch.

Students may check AR books on AR bookfinder at <http://www.arbookfind.com/UserType.aspx>. This will help in choosing books from home or the Public Library. This will explain how many points the book is worth and also what the reading level is.

Guidelines:

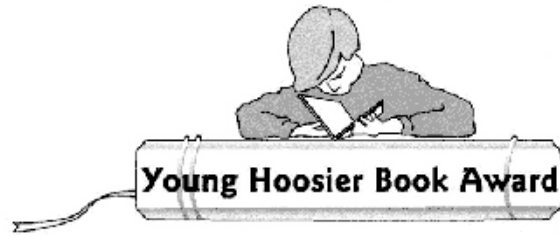
1. Students must read from the Young Hoosier Book Award middle school list to earn the YHBA trophy. Titles are listed on the back. Students may also read any 8 AR books worth at least 5 points to participate in the pizza party.
2. All books must be read from the beginning to the end by the student.
3. When the student is finished with a book, a test must be taken at the BMS library media center using the Accelerated Reader program. A 60% or better must be scored in order for the book to count toward the required books.
4. Quizzes must be taken between the dates of June 13 and August 9. Previously read books will not count.
5. The BMS library media center will be open this summer every Tuesday beginning June 13 between the hours of 5:30 – 6:30 P.M. During this time, students will be allowed to check out books and take the tests. A BMS staff member will be available to help you locate books and navigate the computer when taking the tests. A BMS staff member will also supervise the AR test and initial the results. Dates that the BMS Library Media Center will be open are June 13, 20 and 27; July 11, 18, 25; August 1. **Please note that we will not be open on July 4.**

Copies of the books are also available at the Batesville Memorial Public Library.
