We have been presented with a unique situation. We are asking for everyone's cooperation with this matter. There are students with **life threatening peanut allergies** in our school. They may not be exposed to **OR** ingest **ANY** peanut products.

This means that **they may not touch or eat or smell** the followings:

Peanuts, peanut butter, peanut oil, peanut flour, or peanut protein.

Please realize that these children have **a severe allergy, which could be fatal.** Even during lunch these students are at risk and are seated at designated special peanut free tables. We are asking you to read all food labels before sending any food to school with your child. We are also asking that you talk with your child about the importance of not sharing their personal food with these children.

We thank you in advance for your cooperation. It will take a team effort to create a safe environment for those with anaphylactic peanut allergies.
