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**December 7 and 8, 2015:** A group of twenty-four early Childhood Principals from China visited BPS to learn about Kindergarten curriculum and the BPS Developmental Preschool.

**November 16, 2015:** Dr. Hannah Yin, founder and Principal of Apple Tree School in Beijing China, visited BIS and BPS.

**October 20-31, 2015:** A BCSC administrator traveled to China to participate in the International STEM Fellowship Program sponsored by the IDOE, CEC and Indiana University.

**October 6, 2015:** Batesville Intermediate School hosted twenty-four Chinese Principals. The focus was the PBIS program, elementary curriculum and technology.

**September 2015:** Rodger Lu, a teacher from one of our Sister Schools in China, arrived at BCSC to teach Chinese II to a group of students at BHS.

**August 3, 2015:** As we continued to expand our Global Initiative Program, BCSC hosted ten students from Shanghai International Studies University. The students attended a Summer Camp at Indiana University and visited our school system to learn more about American education.

**July 13-24, 2015:** Three BCSC administrators traveled to Guangzhou, China to teach summer school to elementary and/or middle level students.

**February 2-February 14, 2015:** Winter Academic Camp- Twenty-four students from the High School Affiliated Renming University Beijing attended school at Batesville High School and Batesville Middle School. Chinese students shadowed selected 7th and 8th grade students at the Middle school and then shadowed KSLA Club and Key Club students at the High School. Students stayed with host families in the Batesville community during their visit to Batesville.

**January 12-January 30, 2015:** Batesville Community School Corporation hosted Principal Tan, Tian Chang Elementary School, Hong Zhou, Zhejiang Province. Principal Tan shadowed principals from all four buildings during his visit to Batesville.

**December 10, 2014:** Batesville Community School Corporation hosted a Chinese Delegation Dinner at Hillcrest County Club. The Guest of Honor was Bao Xuejun, Deputy Director of the Zhejiang Provincial Department of Education, and Superintendent Glenda Ritz, Indiana Department of Education.

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**December 2, 2014:** Twenty-five Special Education Principals from China visited Batesville High School to learn about BCSC's teacher evaluation system, visit classrooms, and learn more about the United States education system.

**December 2014:** OMNISEC International Investigations conducted a site visit at Batesville High School for BCSC's Petition for Approval of School for Attendance by Nonimmigrant Students (Form I-17) through the Student and Exchange Visitor Information System (SEVIS).

**October 11-October 21, 2014:** Batesville High School Spanish Teacher, Laura Tucker, traveled to Seville, Spain with Global Indiana to immerse in the history, culture and language of one of the world's most historic cities, form partnerships with Sevillian schools, and collaborate on global education program development. While in Seville, Ms. Tucker participated in the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding with Batesville Community School Corporation's Sister School in Seville. This became BCSC's sixth Sister School.

**August 2014:** Batesville Community School Corporation extended Foreign Language course offering at Batesville High School by adding Chinese. This became the third World Language class offered at BHS, joining Spanish and German.

**July 28-August 1, 2014:** Fourteen elementary students from Tian Chang Elementary School, Hong Zhou, Zhejiang Province attended a BCSC Immersed Cultural Summer Camp at Batesville Middle School. Students stayed with host families in the Batesville community during camp week.

**June 26-July 20, 2014:** Six BCSC educators traveled to China to teach English at the University of Technology and Science Beijing. While in China, BCSC visited four sister schools and signed Memorandums of Understanding with each school.

**November 11-November 12, 2013:** The Principal and an English Teacher from Danghu Senior High School visited Batesville Community School Corporation. They toured the schools and the Principal signed a Memorandum of Understanding to be a Sister School to Batesville High School.

**October 2013:** Batesville Community School Corporation Superintendent, Dr. Jim Roberts, spent ten days in China with Indiana Superintendent of Public Education, Glenda Ritz, and other Indiana Superintendents to kick off Batesville Community School Corporation's Global Initiative.

**August 2013:** Batesville Community School Corporation extended Foreign Language courses by adding Chinese at Batesville Middle School (BMS). This was the first World Language class offered at BMS.
