INDIVIDUALIZED SCHEDULING APPOINTMENT

Students new to BHS will meet with a school counselor. The counselor will review the transfer paperwork from the student's previous school and determine the best schedule, any needed accommodations and provide more enrollment details.



PERSONALIZED TOUR

Each new student will receive a tour after their class schedule has been set. The school counselor will help the student navigate their schedule to find their classrooms, locker, cafeteria and other important locations in the building.



ONE-ON-ONE COMPUTER TRAINING

Each new student will meet one-on-one or in a small group setting with an IT staff member to review, be trained on and check understanding of the online portals used at BHS.



ASSIGNED STUDENT LEADERSHIP PARTNER

Students who transfer to BHS after the first day of school will be assigned a KSLA leadership partner. This is a BHS student who has strong leadership qualities and will help new students transition into the new school setting. During the first week, the KSLA student will assist with navigating the halls, lunchroom seating, SRT, and other student to student questions.



QUARTERLY GRADE CHECK

BHS operates on semester grades. Each new student's grades will be monitored for progress every 4 ½ weeks. If there are academic risks that need to be addressed a counselor will meet with the student and contact the parent/guardian via email and/or letter.

NEW STUDENT GROUP

Each new student will be invited to attend a New Student Group led by a BHS cadet teacher and co-facilitated by a school counselor. The group will meet every three weeks and is designed to help students new to BHS get to know the school better, get to know each other and to have a common place to meet with some familiar faces. The group incorporates fun ice-breaker activities selected by the cadet teacher. Of course, snacks are always served!

MID QUARTER FOLLOW-UP

After the student has settled into their new classes, a school counselor will hold an individual, face to face check-in to see how things are going and answer any student question, etc.
