OVERVIEW

Students starting with the Class of 2023 must meet all of the following:

- 1** Diploma
- 2** Learn & Demonstrate Employability Skills
- 3** Postsecondary-Ready Competencies

1 Diploma *Earn one of the diploma designations*

- Core 40 (All cohorts)
- Academic Honors (2024-2027)
- Technical Honors (2024-2027)
- Honors (2028 + beyond)

2 Employability Skills Work-Based Experience:

- COOP: Manuf., CNA, CCMA
- Southeastern Career Center
- Career Exploration Internship
- Work Based Learning
- Supervised Ag. Experience
- Degree Capstone
- Principles of Teaching

3 Postsecondary-Ready Competencies *Meet at least one of these competencies*

Honors Diploma

SAT

*reading/writing = 480, math = 530

ACT

*english = 18, reading = 22, math = 22, science = 23 (2 out of 4 needed with at least one in English/Reading and one in Math/Science)

ASVAB

*minimum of 31 (intent to enlist form required)

Industry Certification

*certification from approved DWD list

CTE Concentrator

*C average or higher in 2 advanced CTE courses

AP/Dual Credit

*C or higher in 3 courses (1 of the 3 courses must be in core content area or all three must be a part of a CTE pathway)
