Meet at least one of these competencies

Honors Diploma

SAT

*reading/writing = 480, math = 530

ACT

*english = 18, reading = 22, math = 22, science = 23 (2 out of 4 needed with at least one in English/Reading and one in Math/Science)

ASVAB

*minimum of 31 (intent to enlist form required)

Industry Certification

*certification from approved DWD list

CTE Concentrator

*C average or higher in 2 advanced CTE courses

AP/Dual Credit

*C or higher in 3 courses (1 of the 3 courses must be in core content area or all three must be a part of a CTE pathway
