

IMMUNIZATIONS & TUBERCULIN SKIN TESTING

CHILD IMMUNIZATIONS

Vaccines are given on a routine schedule: 2 months, 4 months, 6 months, 1 year, 15 months, 18 months, 4-6 years, 11 years and 16 years.

ROUTINE IMMUNIZATIONS FOR MOST ADULTS

- COVID-19
- Influenza (Yearly)
- Pneumococcal (Starting at age 65)
- RSV (Starting at age 60 AND pregnant women at 32-36 weeks gestational age.)
- Shingles (Starting at age 50)
- Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis - Tdap (Every 10 Years)

IMMUNIZATIONS RECOMMENDED BASED ON HEALTH CONDITIONS, VACCINES RECEIVED AS A CHILD, TRAVEL & OTHER FACTORS

- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Hib
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella
- Meningitis B
- Meningitis (ACWY)
- Pneumococcal (Pevnar 20)
- Rabies
- Shingles (Zoster)
- Tdap
- Varivax (Chickenpox)

TUBERCULIN SKIN TESTING

Otherwise known as TST, TB test, mantoux or PPD. Arrangements will be made for a return visit to have the test read within 48-72 hours after administration.

INSURANCE

We will submit vaccine charges to your insurance. Please contact your insurance company to verify coverage limitations. Immunizations are billed as 'preventive' and may be covered under the wellness category of your insurance plan. The insurance company makes the final determination of your eligibility and coverage.

For children 17 years of age and younger, consent must be provided by a parent or legal guardian.



FREE VACCINE

Children

Free vaccine is available to children 18 years and younger who meet eligibility requirements for the Vaccine for Children program, including:

- Having any form of Medicaid
- Having no health insurance
- Having insurance that does NOT cover vaccines - this does not include insurance plans requiring you to meet your deductible first

Adults

Free influenza, COVID-19 and Tdap vaccines may be available to adults 19 years and older who are either uninsured or underinsured. This does not include those who are Medicaid-eligible or those on high-deductible plans.
