



What is the SEIHC “Free Clinic”?

The Southeast Indiana Health Center, “Free Clinic”, is a primary care health facility in Batesville, serving the medically underserved residents of Franklin and Ripley counties since 2013.

Who is eligible?

To be treated at the Free Clinic, you must

- ◆ Live in Franklin or Ripley County
- ◆ Have no insurance or be underinsured with a large deductible
- ◆ Have a household income below 300% of the federal poverty level
You’ll need to provide a copy of your tax return and/or pay stub please.

What services are offered?

- ◆ Primary and preventive care
- ◆ Acute care (simple injuries, rashes, infections of the respiratory, urinary, or GI tracts or skin)
- ◆ Chronic disease management (diabetes, hypertension, asthma, COPD)
- ◆ Mental health (depression and anxiety management and counseling)
- ◆ Women’s health (paps, pregnancy testing)
- ◆ Sexually transmitted disease testing and treatment
- ◆ Lab services
- ◆ Health education and counseling
- ◆ Referral to specialists

What is not offered?

- ◆ Prescription or refilling of narcotics or any controlled substance
- ◆ Immunizations
- ◆ Prenatal or maternity care
- ◆ Disability evaluation
- ◆ Workers’ compensation evaluation or treatment
- ◆ Major emergency medical care

When are clinics held?

Patients are seen in clinic on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, 5:00 to 7:30 pm.
Appointments are preferred. Please call the clinic for appointments or questions.
