- Improved sequencing for completing the Business Administration Certificate

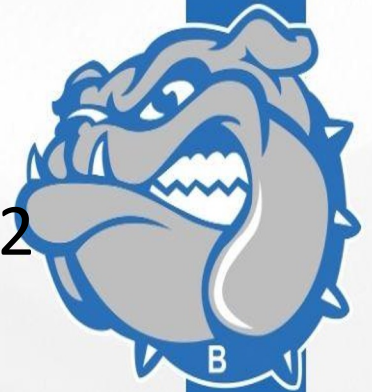

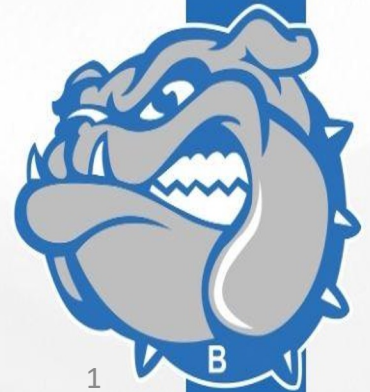

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SENIOR ONLY SCHEDULING OPTIONS

Work Based Learning & English 12

- Batesville High School students in the graduating class of 2025 who have earned six graduation pathway dual credits or are scheduled for completion of a CT (Certificate) or TC (Technical Certificate) have demonstrated competency and therefore all eligible to receive two English 12 credits through a full year of classroom instruction in either Work Based Learning or Career Exploration Internship.
- Students will receive a credit for their work experience in addition to English credit.
- This is a required full year, two semester experience
- Course Titles:
WBL: ENG 12 – Technical Communications
CEI: ENG 12 – Technical Communications

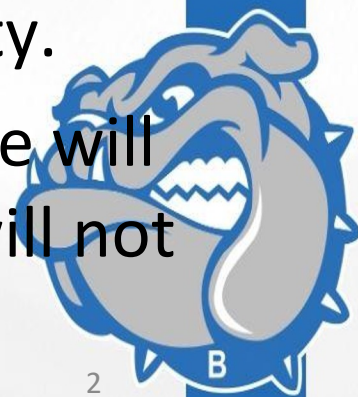

HIGH SCHOOL GUIDANCE

- If BHS is not in session, but Ivy Tech is, then you are expected to attend your Ivy Tech class if at all possible. (Weather permitting)
- BHS dual credit and dual enrollment students do NOT have the ability to withdraw from a grade they earned in an Ivy Tech course. (Such as a regular college student might have the ability.)
- A grade of a D or higher in an Ivy Tech course will be awarded dual credit from Ivy Tech, but will not be transferable to other colleges.

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Earning College Credits



Advanced Placement

Students must score a 3, 4 or 5 on their AP exam to earn college credit. The number of earned credit hours varies by score and course.



Dual Credit

Complete college level coursework in your high school to earn dual credits. Dual credit offerings and higher education partners vary by high school.



Dual Enrollment

Partner with your local Ivy Tech to compliment your dual offerings with dual enrollment courses.

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Dual Credit/Enrollment Admission Process

Dual Credit Self-Registration

- DualEnroll.com - Students are required to create a DualEnroll.com account to self-register for dual credit course(s) each fall and spring.
- Students MUST provide their Social Security Number as part of the DualEnroll account creation process.
- Once the initial account is created, students can login to register for another course, update information and view their dual credit courses.

Course Prerequisites

- Students scheduled for dual credit courses must meet the course prerequisites to earn college credit for the course.
- PSAT, SAT, ACT, GPA and Knowledge Assessment test scores can be used to meet course prerequisites.
- Student eligibility is determined by Ivy Tech with standardized test scores and/or high school transcripts provided by the guidance department.

Transfer

- Students can request an official Ivy Tech transcript after high school graduation to transfer credits to their post-secondary institution.



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Senate Enrolled Act 182 (2012)

- ✓ Created the Statewide Transfer General Education Core (now known as the Indiana College Core)
- ✓ Recognizes 30 credit hours (the first year of college) with a credential
- ✓ Mandates that the full 30 credit hour package transfers into every public, four-year university in Indiana.
